Information Sheet

The Glen, Alcohol and Other Drug Rehabilitation Centre auspiced by Ngaimpe Aboriginal Corporation, consists of two facilities. Our main centre is situated on a forty acre farm at Chittaway Point, approximately 2 kilometres from Tuggerah Station, on the Central Coast of NSW and can accommodate 20 people. We also have a 16 bed facility set on 25 acres at Rothbury in the Hunter Valley. *Clients can be housed at either of these facilities.*

The Glen offers a long-term residential program based on the twelve step programs of Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous. We have group counselling, one to one counselling and work programs, in which all clients are expected to participate. Clients also attend outside meetings of Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous, usually of an evening. The work programs involve general farm duties, i.e. livestock management, garden cultivation and general maintenance.

Clients are required to provide a copy of their full criminal history prior to referral assessment taking place. Referral assessments are conducted by telephone Monday to Thursday between the hours of 9.00 am and 12 noon.

Admission times are Monday to Thursday between 9.am and 12noon

There is a Urine Test conducted prior to admission. *There is a \$50 Urine Test Fee that is not refundable or negotiable.*

The program is approximately three to six months negotiable. The Glen offers a safe environment for those people who wish to do something positive about their addictions. We are a Drug and Alcohol free zone.

The Glen welcomes all men over the age of eighteen who feel that they could benefit from our program.

Clients are advised of the following:

1. Clients must be free of all mood altering substances. We will not accept any person on any form of mood altering medication, this includes the following:

- Valium (Benzodiazapines)
- Panadeine, Panadeine Forte (any medication containing Codeine)
- Methadone
- Anti Depressants or Anti Psychotic medication
- Cold and Flu tablets (Codeine & Psuedoephedrine Hydrochloride)
- The Glen does not have the facilities or trained staff to accept dual diagnosis clients at this time

2. All clients are to arrive by 1200 noon. Clients will be required to submit to a urinalysis on admission. If a positive result is obtained to any thing stronger than aspirin the client can be refused entry. There is a Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) non-refundable urine fee payable.

3. All clients are admitted through the Chittaway Point facility. After admission you can be placed at either facility, you do not have a choice about where you are going to stay.

4. Rent payable – **Newstart \ DSP - \$392.00 per fortnight. Youth Allowance - \$364.00 per fortnight.** Clients must give one weeks notice of intention to leave the program. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of any rent monies paid in advance. Clients who are dismissed from the program will also forfeit any rent monies paid in advance.

5. There is a two week settling in period during which contact with family or friends is not permitted. After this period is over clients are allowed phone calls after 4.30pm weekdays and visitors on Sundays between 1.30pm – 5 pm only.

6. Mobile phones are not permitted. Anyone caught with a mobile phone in their possession will be dismissed immediately.

7. We **do not accept clients** who have a history of the following types of offences

- Malicious wounding
- Assault or robbery involving a weapon of any description
- Sexual or indecent assault.
- Arson
- Murder or Manslaughter

Rent payable is based on payment received from Centrelink.

Urine Test Fee: **\$50.00 Not refundable, not negotiable**

Youth Allowance: **\$364.00** per fortnight plus \$26 extra until 2 weeks ahead

All other benefits: **\$392.00** per fortnight plus \$56 extra until 2 weeks ahead

All clients are entitled to maximum rent assistance whilst resident at this centre. Clients receiving Youth Allowance payments are also entitled to 'Living away from home' allowance
